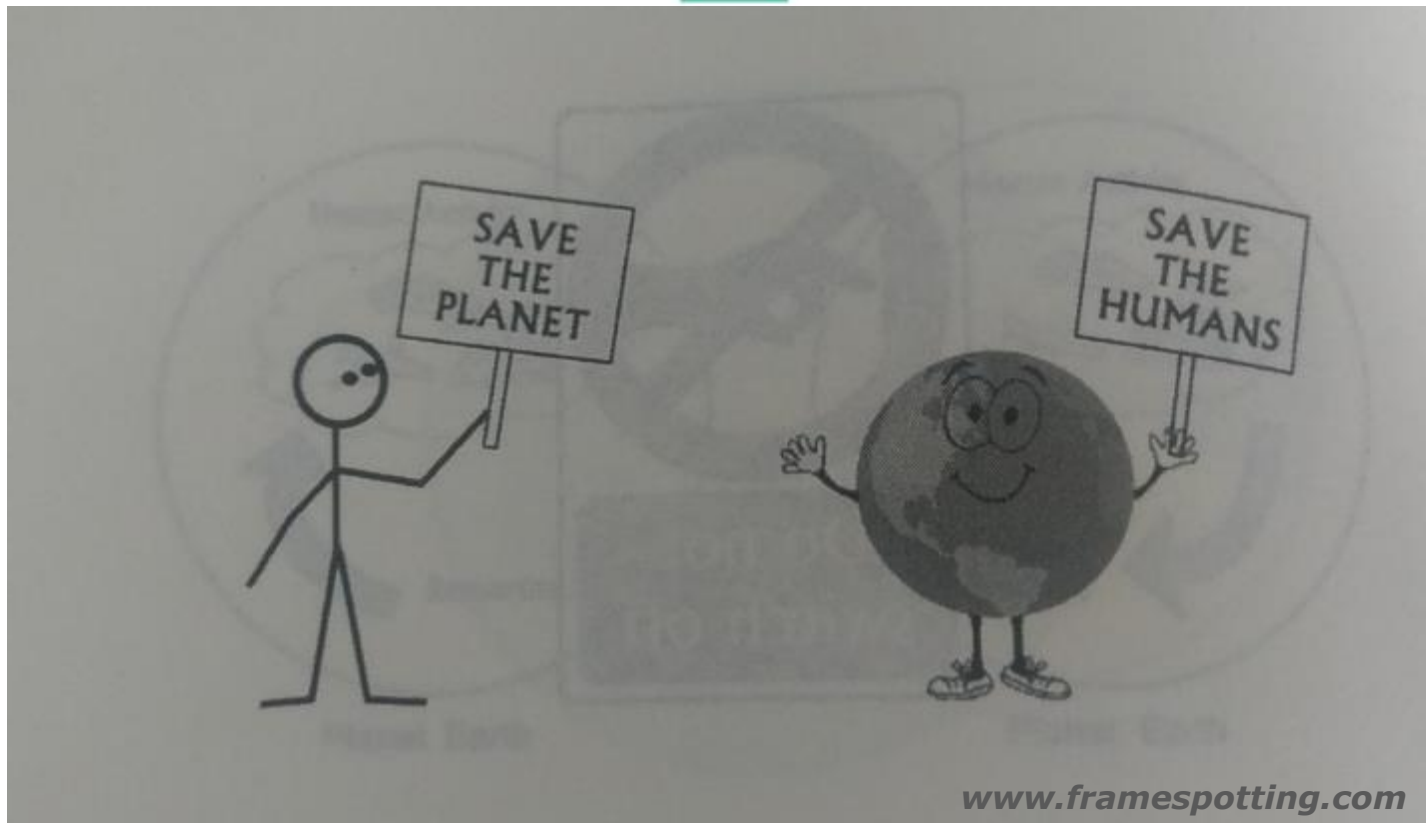

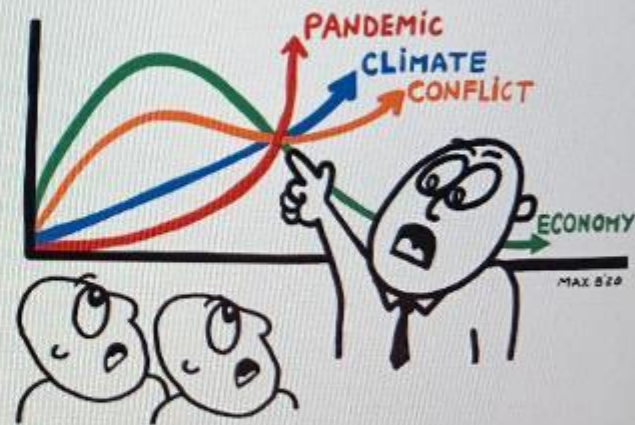
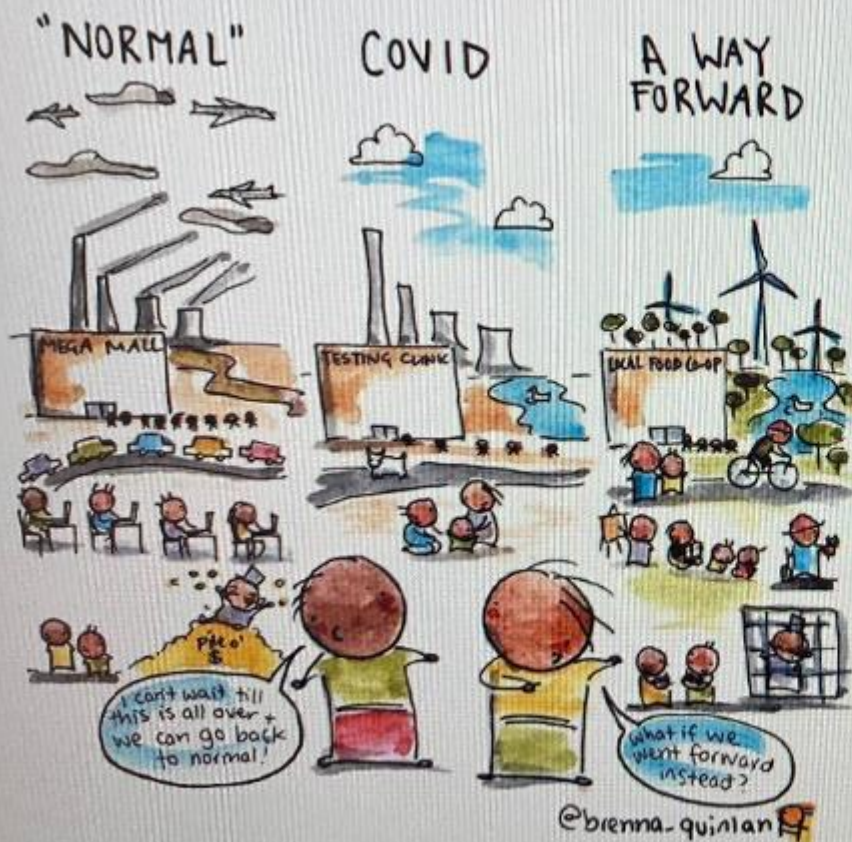

- The disasters are collaborating better than we are!

What happens if we do not act?

Without action on climate change the EU will see, already **within the lifetime of our children:**

Pollution

400,000 premature deaths per year due to air pollution.

Heat & drought

90,000 annual deaths due to heatwaves.

660,000 additional asylum applications per year in the EU (at 5° temperature increase).

16% of species at risk of extinction (at 4.3° C temperature increase).

Economics

€190 billion annual losses projected for a 3° C increase in global average temperature.

Climate change could lead to a **20% food price rise** in 2050.

Floods

Globally, number of **people at risk** of being forced from their homes by river flooding could increase to **50 million** a year.

Taking part – Pledges

Pact pledging system – for ‘Big’ and ‘Small’ to be launched in June

Aims to help **navigate through many existing systems** AND Pact pledges are not meant to be a repetition of what exists:

- Going beyond existing law
- Adding value by asking to go beyond ‘classical’ CO2 reductions pledges – adding ‘people element’:

Engaging employees, suppliers, customers engagement. Including ‘climate slogans’ in campaigns – e.g. UEFA ‘CleanAir’

Think along lifecycle of products and services ‘what else’ can be done and how to reach people

‘Highest aim’: accelerate the necessary transitions

Navigating pledging & reporting schemes

- “Busy space” of pledging and reporting schemes - opportunity for the Pact to increase **coherence** and visibility for organisations involved
- Pact aim: **meets organisations where they are**
- The Pact - neutral supporting party for climate action catering for all types of organisations

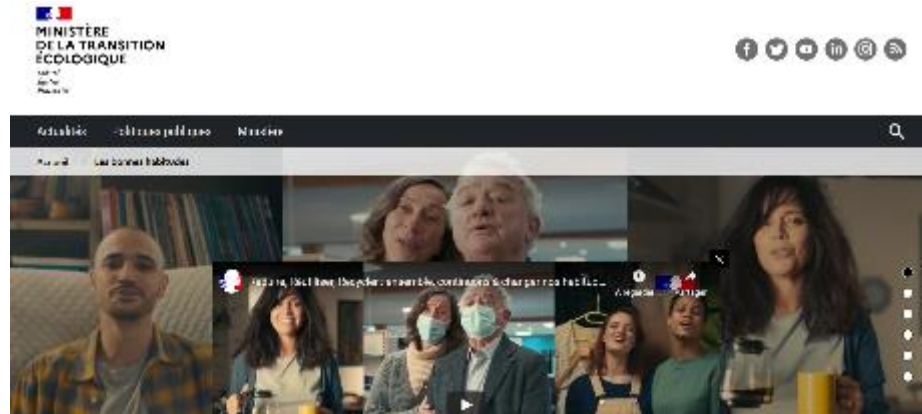


Miasto/region jako partner Paktu – współtworzenie:

Examples of engagement

- ✓ **Citizen assembly in Finland**: consultations with various stakeholders for the preparation of the new climate law to achieve the 2035 carbon neutrality target
- ✓ **Many cities** are drivers of green transition – stakeholders co-creating solutions with cities, e.g. www.greenLahti.fi
- ✓ Communication campaign in **France** about responsible consumption: **“Reduce, reuse, recycle”**
